

Based on your activities, you are unlikely to currently be caught by the EU Al Act. However, you should monitor your businesses activities to ensure that none of your Al outputs are used in the EU, and check whether you owe any obligations following any international business expansion.

Start taking steps to compliance. Failure to do so can result in fines as high as 7% of worldwide turnover or €35million (whichever is greater).
